Key Steps for ICSC Certification:

MEMBERSHIP & ELIGIBILITY

You must be a final-year student or graduate from a CCEI-accredited chiropractic college and a member of your national student chiropractic organization or FICS.



Why Pursue the International Certificate in Sports Chiropractic (ICSC)? The ICSC program, managed by FICS, equips you to work at sports events worldwide. It's the essential qualification for joining a FICS chiropractic team at regional and international events, including the World Games and CSIT Games.

HANDS-ON SEMINARS

Attend two face-to-face seminars, covering upper and lower extremity treatments, held globally. FICS offers student discounts on these seminars, with dates listed on the FICS website.

ONLINE LEARNING

Complete 10 self-paced online modules. Students can apply for a discount code, offering a 20% reduction.

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

Gain hands-on experience by working with a sports team during your studies. If you need help connecting with a team, FICS can help link you with mentors or your national chiropractic body.

FIRST AID REQUIREMENT

A valid First Aid certification (valid within the last two years) is required for ICSC eligibility. Any first aid accreditation recognised in your country is acceptable.
